Footnotes

FLAMIN' HOT raced off the rail on the first turn, settled near the inside on the backstretch, moved closer outside the half-mile pole, bided his time while inside on the far turn, was asked while cutting the corner at the quarter-pole, came out in upper stretch, dropped in inside the furlong marker and closed strongly to get up late. VEILED PROPHET was taken under a good hold, went three wide early on the first turn then tucked into the two path, was reserved towards the rear, moved a bit closer leaving the backstretch, waited while two to three wide on the far turn, shifted four wide and was asked at the top of the stretch, moved out while under a drive, rallied on the outside and closed well but missed. BECKY'S KITTEN went three then two wide on the first turn, moved up to prompt the pace on the outside, drew even with the leader late on the far turn, was asked just after turning into the stretch, battled determinedly into the final sixteenth but also missed while able to get the show. DEPARTURES raced off the rail early on the first bend then dropped to the inside, set the pace through solid fractions, was asked outside the quarter-pole, gamely maintained a slim lead into the final furlong, drifted out some shortly thereafter, battled into the final sixteenth and gave way grudgingly. CONCERT STAGE jostled with CARSON HALL nearing the first turn, was reserved while off the inside, remained on hold on the far turn, was asked near the quarter-pole, moved out under a drive in upper stretch and lacked the needed kick. CARSON HALL jostled with rivals nearing the first turn, went three wide on that bend, settled on the outside, went three wide on the far turn, was asked approaching the quarter-pole, chased under the whip into the final furlong and also lacked the needed kick. LAKE NONA was rated just behind the pacesetter while on

the inside, drafted behind that rival on the far turn, was asked at the top of the stretch, chased under a drive and lacked the needed response. GOOD PROSPECT was fractious in the gate, raced off the rail on the initial turn, settled outside on the backstretch, came under urging while three then four wide on the far turn and failed to rally. RED LEADER was taken in hand shortly after the start, lagged at the rear while on the inside and under restraint, saved ground through the far turn, was asked in the vicinity of the quarter-pole and failed to threaten. BRUCE ALLEY jostled with CARSON HALL nearing the first turn, went three to four wide on that bend, settled outside on the backstretch, went three wide early on the far turn, shifted four wide and was asked outside the quarter-pole then failed to respond.
