WE NEED V L T'S broke sharply, with the runner up directly alongside nearly from the get-go, got hooked up in a protracted duel with that rival, fell back by

a long neck upon reaching the five-sixteenths marker but no more, got called upon as the spirited tussle spilled over into the stretch, reclaimed the lead departing the furlong grounds to gamely prevail over an equally resolute opponent. ABA DABBLER left the gate alertly, sparred on nearly even terms with the top one, racing along the outside, edged away to a slim advantage during the later stages of the run around the bend, turned for home and got set down, with WE NEED V L T'S still battling back furiously, dug in with good determination but lost the advantage nonetheless. LEA THE PUNISHER took the inside route, appeared unsettled and got taken in hand with VINDA in close proximity just to her outside at that juncture, losing a slight amount of real estate and momentum as a result, got going in short order, cut the corner and continued along the rail until the three-sixteenths pole, angled into the two path and continued on willingly to grab show honors. ROUGH WINTER bumped lightly at the start, saved ground throughout and rallied well enough to secure the last major check. VINDA sat well placed in the two path while stalking the pace dispute, flattened out. FLYING SAPPHO thee wide entering the stretch was five wide exiting it, having done so after having put to a long hard drive, mustered up a mild response to mainly improve position. SANSANNAH made slight contact with ROUGH WINTER leaving the starting gate, raced along the outside, was steadied a bit when unsettled just past the half mile pole, settled back into proper stride soon afterwards, lacked the necessary stretch response. BLONDECAT near the inside, was no menace. SILENT DANCING underwent a three wide pursuit, folded. SOTIQUE off the inside as the trailer, was put three wide at the head of the stretch, had no impact. SISTER BERTA departed the backstretch from the three path, was outrun. MISS LIBBY raced along the outside and failed to reach a contending position.
