INNER TURF FOR FILLIES AND MARES THREE YEARS OLD AND UPWARD. No nomination fee. \$1,500 to pass the entry box. A supplemental nomination fee of \$3,000 in addition to the entry fee will be accepted at any time prior to entry. The purse to be divided 60% to the winner, 20% to second, 10% to third, 5% to fourth, 3% to fifth and 2% divided equally among the remaining finishers. Three year olds, 118.; Older 123. Turf weights. Non-winners of a Graded sweepstake twice on the turf in 2012 allowed, 3 lbs.; a Graded sweepstake over a mile and one furlong on the turf in 2012, 5 lbs.; a sweepstake on the turf or four races on the turf, 7 lbs. Dirt Weights; Non-winners of a Graded Sweepstake on the dirt in 2011-12 allowed 2 lbs.; A sweepstake on the dirt in 2011-12; or four races on the dirt, 4lbs.; three races on the dirt, 6lbs. (Maiden, claiming and starter races not considered.) A trophy will be presented to the winning owner. The New York Racing Association reserves the right to transfer this race to the Main Track where dirt allowance weights will apply. In the event that this race is taken off the turf, it may be subject to downgrading upon review by the Graded Stakes Committee. Closed Saturday, August 18, 2012 with 16 Original Nominations and 2 Supplements.

Footnotes

HIT IT RICH broke quickly and went straight to the front, was well rated while setting the pace along the rail, came under urging with a little over a quarter-mile to run, kicked clear in upper stretch and maintained a safe advantage under right hand urging. BIZZY CAROLINE stalked the pacesetter on the outside, came under urging on the final turn, was put to a right-handed whip at the quarter-pole, lost touch with HIT IT RICH in upper stretch, switched to a left-handed whip near the eighth-pole, battled determinedly for the place in the final furlong and just earned that position while unable to threaten the winner. KISSABLE (IRE) saved ground on the first turn, settled in third position, raced a bit off the rail on the second turn, continued in third position while traveling nicely, was roused while a bit off the rail early on the final turn, dropped to the rail late on that bend, cut the corner into the stretch, chased under a left-handed whip and finished willingly to just miss the place. BUBBLY JANE (BRZ) broke out and was last away, dropped to the inside early on the first turn, settled in fifth position, saved ground on the second turn, raced off the rail on the backstretch, was asked near the seven-sixteenths pole, raced three then two wide on the final turn, came under a left-handed whip while getting closer in upper stretch, switched to a right-handed whip inside the furlong marker and gained ground but lacked a winning kick. IMPERIAL PIPPIN threw her head at the start, settled on the inside, was asked leaving the backstretch, came under a right-handed whip near the five-sixteenths pole, saved ground into the stretch, switched to a left-handed whip and gained a bit of ground but lacked the needed response. THISLILSOULOFMINE dropped to the rear early, lagged at the back while on the inside, was given a few taps of the whip near the half-mile pole, saved ground while urged along on the final turn, moved out in upper stretch and failed to threaten.
