HIGH YIELD, away in good order and close up inside early on, advanced three wide approaching the stretch, reached the front nearing the eighth pole, drew clear when roused and widened under a vigorous hand ride. SETTLEMENT, off sluggishly and outrun early, put in a quick three wide move on the turn, came to the inside for the drive and finished gamely. EXCITING STORY, bumped at the start and hustled to the front, set the pace under pressure from SYKES ALIVE and weakened in the final furlong. SYKES ALIVE was hustled from the gate, pressed the pace from the outside and tired in the stretch. AFTERNOON AFFAIR raced four wide and had no response when roused. TROUBLE CITY, steadied between rivals on the backstretch, chased inside and tired in the stretch. BUFFALO PRAYER raced wide and tired. Z COOL, bumped at the start, was steadied on the backstretch and tired. CHANCELLOR M. H. was bumped at the start, stumbled after the start, was hustled on the backstretch, chased the pace and tired.
