HOOK AND LADDER flashed good speed while between rivals, set the pace, drew away in the stretch and widened under a vigorous hand ride. NUNZIO came wide into the stretch and rallied to earn the place award. NEVADA STRIP raced with the pace while four wide, could not deal with the winner in the stretch and was outfinished for the place spot. TINSELTOWNER stumbled at the start, contested the pace along the inside and tired in the stretch. BIEN LUCIDO (CHI) chased inside and tired in the final furlong. CAJUN CONCERT contested the pace while three wide and tired in the stretch. THE DODGER broke slowly and raced wide. DURING THE ACT raced inside and tired.
