MIDAS EYES raced close up early while in hand, advanced three wide on the turn, responded when roused in upper stretch, drew clear then dug in gamely and held CLOCK STOPPER safe under a drive. CLOCK STOPPER was outrun early, came wide into the stretch and finished gamely outside but could not get to the winner. GYGISTAR bobbled after the start, raced in hand along the inside early, came wide for the drive and finished gamely outside. STRONG HOPE raced with the pace from the outside, gained a short lead on the turn then tired along the inside in the final furlong. UNFORGETTABLE MAX was hustled along early, raced inside and offered a mild rally on the rail. GOLD DOLLAR was outrun early, came wide into the stretch and lacked a rally. A HUEVO was outrun early, raced between rivals and had no response when roused. YESSIRGENERALSIR quickly opened a clear lead, set the pace along the inside and tired in the stretch. EAVESDROPPER raced three wide and tired.
