STAKES Saranac S. Grade 3 - Thoroughbred

FOR THREE YEAR OLDS. By subscription of \$100 each, which should accompany the nomination; \$500 to pass the entry box; \$500 to start, with \$100,000 added. The added money and all fees to be divided 60% to the winner, 20% to second, 10% to third, 5% to fourth, 3% to fifth and 2% divided equally among remaining finishers. 123 lbs. TURF: Non-winners of \$60,000 twice on the turf in 2005 allowed 2 lbs.; such a race in 2005, 4 lbs.; \$45,000 on the turf; or three races on the turf, 6 lbs.; \$45,000 or two races at a mile or over, 8 lbs. DIRT: Non-winners of \$40,000 at a mile or over on the dirt allowed 3 lbs.; two races at a mile or over on the dirt, 5 lbs.; two races, 7 lbs. (Maiden, claiming, starter and restricted allowance races not considered for dirt and turf). A trophy will be presented to the winning owner. The New York Racing Association reserves the right to transfer this race to the Main Track. In the event that this race is taken off the turf, it may be subject to downgrading upon review by the Graded Stakes Committee. Closed Saturday, August 20, 2005 with 24 Nominations. (If the Stewards consider it inadvisable to run this race on the turf course, this race will be run at One Mile and One Eighth on the main track.).

JAMBALAYA raced with the pace while in hand, dug in determinedly when roused in upper stretch and got the nod after a hard drive. SILVER WHISTLE was taken back after the start, was rated along outside, rallied four wide on the second turn, dug in gamely outside and just missed. WOODLANDER was rated along inside, saved ground and stayed on well to the finish. ZURICH (IRE) was rated along between rivals, came wide into the stretch and lacked a rally. CROWN POINT was outrun early, came four wide into the stretch and offered a mild rally outside. CHESTERTOWN SLEW quickly showed in front, set the pace along the inside and tired in the final furlong. PALLADIO was outrun early, raced inside and had no response when roused. PORT CHESTER raced close up early, chased the pace, came three wide into the stretch and tired. MESAWMI was unprepared for the start, was off slowly and never recovered.
