

## Footnotes

CIRCULAR QUAY raced far back after breaking slowly and checking slightly inside UNBRIDLED EXPRESS leaving the gate, trailed to the turn, saved ground while launching his bid nearing the quarter pole, swerved out while rapidly gaining at the three-sixteenths pole then unleashed a powerful late run in the middle of the track to win going away. SCAT DADDY steadied after stumbling at the start, rushed up along the backstretch, lodged a brief move along the inside to threaten at the half mile pole, was shuffled back while lacking room along the inside on the far turn, angled out after regaining his momentum midway on the turn, angled between horses to threaten leaving the quarter pole, dueled heads apart for the lead inside the furlong marker but couldn't withstand the winner's late charge while clearly best of the others. UNBRIDLED EXPRESS was taken in hand along the backstretch, settled just off the pace for a half, lodged a three wide move to challenge at the top of the stretch, gained a brief lead nearing the furlong marker then weakened under pressure in the final sixteenth. PEGASUS WIND rushed up from outside to contest the early pace, battled through brisk fractions to the top of the stretch, fought heads apart into midstretch and tired from his early efforts. IRISH ACE rushed up along the rail, dueled heads apart along the inside for five furlongs and gave way in the stretch.
