TOBRUK saved ground to the turn, swung out in upper stretch and closed steadily to get up in the final strides. HERE COMES ART sprinted clear soon after the start, raced uncontested on the lead into upper stretch, battled into deep stretch and yielded late. GAMBLIN FEVER saved ground while trailing to the turn, angled out and rallied belatedly. QUIET ON THE TEE was rated along the inside, rallied along the rail to reach contention in upper stretch and weakened late. PEGASIAN raced along the inside under a firm hold to the turn and lacked a late response. CARDIFF ROAD failed to mount a serious rally. VICTORY ASSURED went evenly. RELATIVELY READY was outrun for seven furlongs, swung five wide and lacked a rally. OEDIPUS O'NEAL raced just behind the pacesetter to the top of the stretch and gave way. GOLD PAGEANTRY raced up close in hand and faltered on the turn.
