Footnotes

CITY TRAIN had little difficulty clearing the field to establish early command, set the fractions, well rated, uncontested and towards the inside, began to shake off his closer pursuer approaching the quarter pole, spurted away, having now been asked for run, then held sway while being kept to the task at hand. RUNAWAY JIM reserved while racing off the inside, was put to encouragement at the five-sixteenths pole, swerved inward several paths in upper stretch, got put back back on a truer course in short order and was along for the place. N P CAT took the inside route, remained on hold, just behind a rival's heels coming to the quarter pole, found room to maneuver outward in the vicinity of the three-sixteenths pole, and finished willingly to be well in front of the rest for show honors. BOURBON BANDIT well placed tracking the pacesetter from the pocket, failed to fire once called upon. WHATEVERTTAKES weakly pursued the leader from the outside for three-quarters before backing off. WRITETHATDOWN saved ground, was given four hard shots right handed in rapid succession in the vicinity of the three-sixteenths pole, before being tentatively ridden out the remainder of the way. WESTERN CONNECTION three wide around the opening bend, took advantage of an opportunity to swing into the two path midway along the backstretch, tired after completing six furlongs. ROARING CONQUEST wrangled early, sat towards the back of the pack from the outside, swung four wide into the lane but failed to muster a solid stretch offering. RIVER IN THE WOODS was no menace. NO MORE TAXES rank being placed under a snug hold soon after leaving the gate, was always outrun.
