Footnotes

MR. FANTASY away in good order, needed only a few strides out of the starting gate to establish command under his own power, showed the way slightly off the inside, entered the stretch still with a clear advantage, and still not having asked for run, scurried away from the competition during the run through the furlong grounds, then continued to edge away authoritatively under a light hand ride. CALLIDE VALLEY was maneuvered over to the rail midway down the backstretch, was always inside thereafter, and displayed a good rail rally during the stretch drive to take the place. BROTHER BIRD urged chasing the winner throughout, was outfinished after turning for home. SAFE TRIP pursued the top one from the three path, issued his challenge for the lead nearing the quarter pole, failed to make any headway, while attempting to lug inward in upper stretch, steadily tired leaving the eighth pole. KENS CAPE bumped at the start, rode along the rail, angled outward, setting into the four path at the head of the stretch, was called upon but had no serious stretch offering. SPEIGHT OF HAND bumped at the start, saved ground during the opening stages, began a gradual maneuver to the outside, was positioned in the three path by the five-sixteenths pole, turned for home and flattened out. FLYING PEGASUS along the outside, was outrun. SOUTHERN DANGER three wide, was through after going a half.
