Footnotes

TOCCO D'ORO was well rated on an easy lead, responded well when set down in upper stretch, was put to a left-handed whip inside the furlong marker, drifted out near the wire and held sway under left hand urging. SHIMMERING FOREST was taken in hand early then reserved on the outside, shifted three wide near the five-sixteenths pole then was roused, lugged inward in the stretch, remained well behind the leader into the final furlong, closed well while continuing to lug in a bit and missed while clear for the place. LION UNDER OATH settled in the middle of the field while off the hedge, was roused with three furlongs to run, raced off the hedge while urged along on the far turn, dropped to the inside in upper stretch and finished with good courage for the show. GOLLY DAY settled on the inside, came off the hedge near the five-sixteenths pole, swung three wide leaving the far turn, came out for room in upper

stretch, was kept in by ALBANY ROAD, bumped multiple times with that rival, found clear room in the final furlong and finished willingly but missed the show. ALBANY ROAD was unhurried towards the rear while on the outside, went three wide on the far turn, was roused in the vicinity of the five-sixteenths pole, came four wide into the stretch, bumped multiple times with GOLLY DAY near the three-sixteenths pole and also finished willingly. AVENGING raced inside on the first turn, moved out a bit early on the backstretch, settled in a nice position, shifted three wide and was roused early on the final turn, continued three wide into the stretch and lacked the needed response. CULLINAN lagged well back in the field while towards the inside, angled out in upper stretch and improved position near the middle of the course. EPICURUS angled in sharply after the start, dropped to the hedge, settled on the inside, saved ground into the stretch and failed to rally. SOUTHERN SAINT was taken in hand early, stalked the pace on the outside, was asked to pursue the leader near the five-sixteenths pole, chased into the stretch and gave way. LAMAR VALLEY raced three wide on the first turn, was unhurried at the back, went two to three wide on the far turn, came four wide into the stretch, was carried out near the three-sixteenths pole and failed to threaten. GRAND BLACK JAK settled off the pace, raced off the hedge on the turns and failed to respond when called upon. SOLAR PANEL was rated on the inside, came under urging while continuing to save ground on the far turn and faded. (Rail at Hedge)
