GRACE HALL settled on the outside, went two then three wide on the turn, shifted four wide outside the quarter-pole, rallied under left hand urging in upper stretch, switched to a right-handed whip inside the furlong marker, closed well to get the lead entering the final sixteenth then edged clear under a hand ride late. JUDY THE BEAUTY chased the pace on the outside then three wide on the turn, made a bid coming to the quarter-pole, inched clear under a left-handed whip in upper stretch, drifted out slightly near the furlong marker, lost the lead entering the final sixteenth and was outfinished while well clear for the place. AND WHY NOT broke a bit slow then was carried in, raced well back in the field, came a bit off the inside on the turn and got up for the show. GEORGIE'S ANGEL broke in at the start, moved up to contest the pace, vied inside on the turn, was put to a drive in upper stretch and weakened. TRUE FEELINGS settled at the rear of the field, saved ground on the turn, swung four wide at the top of the stretch and failed to threaten. BAFFLE ME came out a bit at the start, resisted the rating tactics of the rider near the five-eighths pole, threw her head leaving the backstretch, had trouble negotiating the turn while four to five wide, drifted six wide into the stretch and was no factor. BORN BULLISH contested the pace on the outside, vied outside on the turn, dropped out at the top of the stretch and tired. LADY PECAN moved up while urged along, went three wide on the turn and faltered.
