ARENA ELVIRA bumped lightly with ALL ABOUT ALEX just out of the starting gate, was heading for the opening bend four wide, when taken hold, eased back a bit and tucked into the two path in time for the run around the first turn, swung outward midway down the backstretch, was released from a firm hold and closed in on the front runners, departed the backstretch three wide, steadily advanced and took over late on the far turn, using primarily her natural speed, turned for home with a clear advantage and got asked for a response, emerged from the furlong grounds holding her biggest advantage, held safely to the end. SATANS QUICK CHICK darted over to the inside soon after the start, contently rode the rail, was kept on hold, positioned just off a wall of rivals spread outward from the rail to the three path, angled quickly to be in the four path at the head of the stretch and took off in earnest after the leader, cut into that opponent's margin during the last eighth, but had to settle for being second best. LACIE SLEW secured a forward spot in the early going, was rated prompting the pacesetter from the two path until the half mile pole, was asked for some run to keep pace departing that station, left the three-eighths pole under strong hand encouragement, proved no match for the top twosome in the stretch. CONNIE AND MICHAEL off to a quick start, showed the way, being rated along the inside, readily succumbed once challenged late on the far turn and retreated. ALL ABOUT ALEX made light contact with the top one leaving the starting gate, was grabbed hold to prevent additional bumping, made her way three wide towards the first turn, with the rider atop with a snug grip on the reins, stalked from there before taken a bit closer to the inside nearing the end of the stretch, was through after completing three-quarters.
