HEART OF DESTINY bumped with a rival at the start, moved in before the first turn, was reserved on the inside, bided her time while along the hedge on the far turn, was asked at the quarter-pole, moved around SALSA MAMBO in upper stretch, dropped back to the inside around the eighth-pole, rallied furiously along the hedge in the final furlong and got up at the wire. PIANIST went two to three wide on the first turn, stalked the pace on the outside, made a bid early on the far turn, edged clear when set down in upper stretch, drifted out a bit near the furlong marker, led into the final sixteenth but was denied at the wire. KARLOVY VARY bumped with a rival at the start, was reserved while off the pace, raced inside on the far turn, came out in upper stretch and finished willingly for the show. FORMATIVE was a bit eager while in hand early then rated on the inside, was asked near the five-sixteenths pole, came three wide into the stretch, chased PIANIAST while under a drive, altered to the inside of that rival near the furlong marker and finished willingly but missed the show. GOLDRUSH GIRL was hard to load, lingered well back in the field, waited while blocked behind rivals on the far turn, dropped to the inside outside the quarter-pole, followed HEART OF DESTINY into the stretch, came under a drive, moved out near the furlong marker and finished with good energy. LADY OF SHAMROCK broke about three lengths behind the field, went three wide on the first turn, settled on the outside, went four wide on the far turn and lacked the needed response. ZULTANITE went three wide on the first turn, settled while off the inside, was roused on the far turn and failed to rally. DIVINE LUCK saved ground on the first turn, came out early on the backstretch, was unhurried towards the rear, went three then four wide on the first turn, came five wide into the stretch and failed to threaten. SALSA MAMBO was fractious in the gate then backed out and reloaded, set the pace along the hedge, was challenged early on the far turn, lost to

turn then dropped to the two path, settled well back in the field, came under urging while off the inside on the far turn, shifted out near the three-sixteenths pole and was no factor. CAROLINA LIGHT broke a bit slow, lagged well back in the field, went three wide on the far turn, was carried out near the three-sixteenths pole and was no factor. DANCING SOLO went four wide on the first turn, moved up on the outside, chased three wide on the far turn and came up empty.
