LUCKY ROBERTO, close up outside while in hand, moved three wide on the turn and finished determinedly from the outside to get up in the final yards. TACTICAL CAT set the pace under pressure from EXCESS THRILLING, was briefly clear in the stretch then dug in gamely to the wire. TIME BANDIT was hustled inside on the backstretch, chased the pace on the rail and lacked a solid finishing kick. ALY'S ALLEY, outrun early, was hard-riden inside and was going well along the inside late. PRIME DERECTIVE, rated along inside, came wide for the drive and lacked a response. EXCESS THRILLING pressed the pace from the outside into the stretch and tired. PETTIT'S QUEST raced wide and tired in the stretch.
