HUMAITA (GER) raced close up outside while in hand, responded when roused in upper stretch, dug in gamely outside and prevailed under a drive. WHERE WE LEFT OFF (GB) raced close up inside while well in hand, saved ground throughout, got through on the rail in the stretch and dug in gamely to the wire. SAVEDBYTHELIGHT quickly showed in front, set the pace along the inside and weakened in the final furlong. LADY LIBERTY was outrun early, raced inside, rallied nearing the stretch and finished gamely. ALTERNATE prompted the pace from the outside while in hand and tired in the final furlong. STRATEGY (GB) was rated along inside, saved ground and lacked a rally. OCEAN SILK was unhurried while outrun early, raced inside, came wide into the stretch and had no rally. SHINING JEWEL was rated along early, raced between rivals, was three wide on the final turn and tired in the stretch. GAL O GAL was outrun early, raced four wide on the final turn and tired in the stretch.
