Footnotes

KINSELLA raced in midpack, gained outside on the turn, rallied four wide in upper stretch and edged clear in the late stages. WHITLEY raced in good position to the turn and finished well between horses to gain the place. NORTH COUNTRY was reserved for six furlongs, swung four wide on the turn and rallied belatedly. EXTRA ZIP pressed the pace from outside, battled inside the winner into midstretch and tired. GROUND FROST raced under a firm hold along the rail, split horses while gaining in midstretch and finished well in the final sixteenth. WARN was outrun to the turn, swung five wide and closed late from outside. RODMAN stalked three wide to the turn and tired. PRESSURE POINT was used up setting the early pace. PERFECT EASTER saved ground to the turn and lacked room while rallying in midstretch. MARIA'S CHARM steadied in traffic on the far turn and gave way.
