INCLUDE THE CAT away quickly from the starting gate, dropped back towards the rear of the pack in short order, was in a constant struggle with the rider, trying to bear out throughout the run down the backstretch and around the bend, requiring right handed pressure from the rider to prevent too much loss of ground, was eventually fanned five wide into the lane, commenced to rally after being straightened away, closed rapidly during the run through the furlong grounds, taking charge by the eighth pole, edged away under hand encouragement, before being flashed the stick from the right side during the late stages. SORTILEGE urged along on the turn to keep pace, swung four wide into the stretch and came home willingly. GRACE'N STYLE took the inside route, was kept on hold just behind rival's heels coming to the quarter pole, gained room to rally when the rail opened up soon after turning for home, narrowed in, altered course in the vicinity of the eighth pole and displayed enough of a kick to earn the show. QUIPPERY parked off the ongoing pace dispute up ahead, was asked for run, while making a three wide move from the five-sixteenths pole, advanced boldly from the head of the stretch to the furlong marker to loom a serious threat, only to flatten out. SPEAK FREELY dueled along the inside under light encouragement, remained a prominent factor until midstretch and gave way. ELAROSE raced along the outside, was urged along to keep pace, ducked to the rail coming to the five-sixteenths pole, was forced to be kept on hold, stuck in traffic at the quarter pole, eventually having to steady at the three-sixteenths pole, angled outward soon afterwards, and finished primarily under her own courage to the wire. TEXAS AGGIE chased the pace battlers from three path before settling into the two path approaching the quarter pole, was boxed in as the field headed into the lane, angled free by upper stretch, but had no stretch offering after being called upon. EVE OF DESTRUCTION rushed up to a forward position after the break, disputed the pace from the two path until upper stretch and faltered.
