**Footnotes**

UP FOR LOVE patiently rode the hedge, under a good hold for over three-quarters, found room to maneuver into the two path at the top of the lane, began to advance into contention, split rivals at the eighth pole, continued onward, split a different pair of opponents in the vicinity of the sixteenth pole, this time going through a much narrower opening, collared the energetically handled SYZYGY in deep stretch, under light hand urging to prove best. SYZYGY three entering the opening bend, took advantage of an opportunity to be taken inward at midpoint, saved ground throughout thereafter, moved up into a good striking position during the late stages of the run around the far turn, scooted up a clear pathway at the quarter pole, was driven to take command at the eighth pole, dug in when the top one drew abreast leaving the sixteenth pole, failed to stave off that one, but continued on well under strong handling to preserve the place. SHIPPING NEWS rated prompted the pacesetter from the two path, moved when ready nearing the three-eighths pole, continued the fight for the front during the ensuing quarter of a mile, wasn't up to keep up with the two twosome but held well to earn the show. JACOB'S DREAM off the inside, advanced readily into contention after going six furlongs, swung three wide into the stretch, momentarily lacked optimal racing clearance, angled free

in the vicinity of the three-sixteenths pole and came home willingly down the center of the course en route for the last major share. WON O WON sluggish leaving the starting gate, rode the hedge while bringing up the back of the pack, angled outward for the stretch run, and displayed late foot. BETH'S KITTEN placed under a snug hold during the straightaway approach to the first turn, took the inside route, slipped into the two path at the quarter pole, failed to muster up the needed kick when asked. BRUNELLI stalked the pacesetter until upper stretch and gave way. PONTE VECCHIO within range, fanned four wide into the stretch but had no serious stretch offering. IL SENATORE underwent a three to four wide journey, had no rally. RAPPAPORT established command soon after the start, set the pace from the inside, rated until the three-eighths pole, was put to the test by SHIPPING NEWS, succumbed by upper stretch and faded. GOTTA GO ROUND three wide to four around both turns, was put to encouragement on the second bend, steadily tired after completing six furlongs. NUGGET OF WISDOM returned bleeding.
