CRAFTY MAN, rated along outside, raced wide around both turns, dug in resolutely through the stretch and got up on the wire. MT. ARROW was hustled to the front, set the pace while well in hand then dug in gamely along the rail through the stretch. PRIVATELY HELD flashed good speed from the outside while in hand, prompted the pace into the stretch, earned a short lead nearing the furlong marker but weakened while racing a bit greenly in the late stages. PLEASANT BREEZE, with the pace along the rail while under a stout hold, came three wide approaching the stretch and stayed on gamely to the finish. SKY APPROVAL, rated along early, advanced five wide nearing the stretch and lacked a solid finishing punch. MOMSMERCEDES, outrun early, put in a run along the rail on the second turn but had nothing left for the stretch drive.
