AMELIA'S SONG showed good speed from the start, pressed the pace from the outside, drew clear when roused then dug in gamely and held on under a drive. OATSEE raced close up inside while in hand and finished gamely. SALLYBROOKE, unhurried inside early, rallied four wide approaching the stretch and finished gamely from the outside. PROMISING AFFAIR chased the pace while three wide and tired in the stretch. SALTY COUNTESSA set the pace along the inside and tired. LUMINATE raced wide and had no response when roused. SALLY ELLIS tired.
