TANGO TALES was outrun early, came wide into the stretch and rallied to get the place award. SHOW BOOT contested the pace from the outside and tired in the final furlong. CASPER PETERSON contested the pace along the inside and tired in the stretch. STORM LEGACY was outrun early, raced three wide and had no response when roused. WHY OH WHY was outrun early, raced inside and had no rally. BLAZING SONG was outrun early, raced on the rail and tired. MAYTOWN raced close up inside, came wide into the stretch and tired. SUM MARVAL raced three wide and tired.
