HOT DIXIE CHICK pressed the early pace along the rail, was in hand while easing back slightly at the three-eighths pole, saved ground to the turn, charged through along the rail to take command in upper stretch and edged away under intermittent right hand encouragement. BEAUTICIAN forced the pace three wide for a half, lodged a move from outside in upper stretch but was no match for the winner while clearly best of the others. BICKERSONS set the pace under pressure between horses to the top of the stretch and tired from her early efforts. SASSY IMAGE was well placed just off the pace from five furlongs and lacked a strong closing bid. MAGIC APPEAL bobbled and bumped with SNAP HAPPY at the start, raced between horses to the turn and lacked a strong closing response. OPUS A saved ground while trailing for a half after breaking slowly, drifted out in upper stretch and lacked a late response. SKY FEVER saved ground while far back to the turn and failed to menace while drifting out. SNAP HAPPY bumped at the start, was outrun for five furlongs, drifted wide at the quarter pole and lacked a further response.
