Footnotes

CANNONBALL raced in hand early, saved ground while gaining on the turn, angled three wide in upper stretch and closed late under strong left hand urging to get up in the final strides. SILVER TIMBER pressed the pace between horses, gained a slim lead in midstretch, battled into deep stretch and yielded grudgingly. AHVEE'S DESTINY dueled along the rail the entire way and yielded late. MOHEGAN SKY was outrun after breaking slowly and rallied mildly in the late stages. CITIFEST stumbled at the start, stalked four wide for a half and steadily tired thereafter. KARAKORUM ELEKTRA pressed three wide and drifted out while tiring at the quarter pole.
