YANKEE FOURTUNE came away clearly in front then was asked a bit, was well rated under a snug hold with an easy lead, powered further ahead when set down in upper stretch and drew off under a vigorous drive. JOHANNESBURG SMILE was restless in the gate, came away in good order, was taken in hand nearing the first turn, raced off the hedge while under a tight hold, was given free rein on the far turn, dropped to the inside at the top of the stretch and earned the place while no match for the winner. BILLIONS BOY was fractious in the gate then hustled from the start, decided against contesting the pace and was taken in hand before the first turn, raced three wide on that turn, stalked the pace on the outside while under restraint, chased the winner on the far turn and proved no match then was outfinished for the place but earned the show. STRONG COMMITMENT was caught three to four wide on the first turn, raced on the outside while under a hold, went three then four wide on the far turn and failed to rally. QUICK TO CHARM was reserved on the inside, moved out and was roused near the five-sixteenths pole, raced between rivals into upper stretch and failed to threaten. TAPIT'S BREW went four wide on the first turn, dropped in at the back of the field, raced inside early on the far turn, moved to the outside nearing the five-sixteenths pole, swung five wide into the stretch, drifted in behind rivals near the three-sixteenths pole, was straightened by the rider and failed to menace. YANKEE EMPIRE raced three wide on the first turn, was reserved on the outside, went three wide on the far turn, was roused in the vicinity of the five-sixteenths pole and failed to respond. GOOD PROSPECT was fractious in the gate, dropped towards the back then was reserved between rivals, continued between rivals through the far turn, came three wide into the stretch and also failed to respond. CEDROS broke a bit awkwardly, was well placed on the inside, came up empty on the far turn and faded. (Temporary Rail at 9 Feet Only on Far Turn)
