AWAKINO CAT was urged some while near the inside, bided his time while inside on the turn, moved out in upper stretch, rallied into the final furlong, closed determinedly under right hand urging and got up late to prevail. RAVALO dueled on the outside of AFFIRMATIF through blistering fractions, was asked for more while leading into the final furlong, led past the sixteenth-pole but was caught while able to maintain the place. YIELD BOGEY dropped back at the start, settled at the rear of the field, went two then three wide on the turn, came four wide into the stretch and finished with good energy to get the show. AFFIRMATIF dueled on the inside of RAVALO, was put to the whip just inside the furlong marker and was outfinished then caught for the show. PERFECT OFFICER settled between rivals, lacked room behind horses in upper stretch, found clear room near the furlong marker and lacked the needed kick. MITIGATION was reserved towards the rear of the field, waited behind rivals while under a good hold on the turn, found room near the inside in upper stretch but lacked the needed response. OUR FRIEND HARVEY tracked the pace on the outside, went three wide on the turn, was asked to go after the leaders outside the quarter-pole, chased into upper stretch then weakened. (Rail at Hedge)
