ARUNA off to a sluggish beginning, sat reserved toward the rear of pack, began to swing into action leaving the three-eighths pole, drafted behind MOLLY MOLLY MOLLY as that pair fanned four wide into the stretch, tipped out an additional two paths at the head of the stretch, took off in earnest, having now been roused, charged down the outside of the course, collaring the leader in the final stride to earn the decision. PICTURE HAT took charge soon after the start, cut the fractions, well rated and along the inside, on a loosely-contested lead, was let out a notch, with a host of rivals gearing up for the stretch drive, emerged from the furlong grounds still holding a clear advantage, and still being hotly pursued by the aforementioned rivals, dug in gamely only to get nailed right at the wire. CRAZY CATLADY took the inside route while saving ground, continued to bide her time upon entering the far turn, found sufficient room to wiggle outward into the two path in the vicinity of the five-sixteenths pole, was forced to remain on hold, wedged between rivals coming to the quarter pole, found additional room to angle three wide into the lane, took off after the front runners, having now been called upon. displayed good energy en route for the show. OUCHY NIGHT was unhurried while saving ground, angled into the two path in preparation for the stretch drive, closed readily, angled outward a bit more midstretch for clearer sailing, and finished with good courage to grab the last major share. SOTIQUE tracked the leader from the pocket, under a good hold, was put to encouragement after turning for home, kept pace with the front runner, found herself boxed in leaving the eighth pole, with the leader up front, and BIZ JET racing along to her outside, then brushed with BIZ JET, while in a bit tight, after that foe drifted inward during the late stages. MOLLY MOLLY MOLLY angled sharply over to the two path during the straightaway approach to the opening bend, sat reserved from there until the half mile pole, entered the second turn from the three path, but was soon in the four path, advanced steadily departing the three-eighths pole, fanned four wide into the stretch, but made no significant gains thereafter. BIZ JET (BRZ) was rated prompting the leader for nearly three-quarters from the outside, was asked for a response turning for home, kept up the pursuit until about the sixteenth pole, was taken in hand, while appearing to weaken, drifted inward, bothering and putting SOFTIQUE in a bit tight in deep stretch. RIVER FOREST unhurried, was taken out to three path leaving the half mile pole, failed to reach a contending position. LOXY LADY strung out five wide around the second turn, never threatened.
