Footnotes

FRIVOLOUS BUCK went three wide on the first turn, settled on the outside, went three then four wide on the far turn, was given her cue near the five-sixteenths pole, took off in earnest once straightened for the drive, rallied under right hand urging into the final furlong, was switched to a left-handed whip in the vicinity of the sixteenth-pole, battled gamely between rivals late and prevailed by the slimmest of margins in a three-way photo. GITCHEE GOOMIE steadied after the start, raced off the hedge on the first turn, was reserved near the back, came under some urging with a half-mile to run, moved out while under urging on the far turn, shifted four wide near the five-sixteenths pole, swung five wide into the stretch, rallied on the far outside, closed furiously under strong left hand urging and just missed. TUTTI VA BENE broke outward but was quickly corrected, raced off the hedge on the first turn, prompted the pace, engaged AUSTRALIS PRINCESS on the far turn, responded well when set down at the top of the stretch, inched clear passing the eighth-pole, battled gamely in the final furlong, drifted out some under repeated right hand urging late and was denied. GLORY IN MOTION was reserved on the inside, slipped through a tight opening while skimming the hedge in upper stretch and improved position while lacking the needed late kick. LATEDAY EDITION raced three wide on the first turn, tracked the pace on the outside, chased three wide on the far turn, held a good striking position into the final furlong then weakened. CAN SHE DANCE bumped lightly with a rival at the start, went three wide on the first turn, dropped in near the five-eighths pole, raced inside on the far turn, moved out in upper stretch and improved position. CENTRINA raced inside on the first turn, was reserved while off the hedge, went two then three wide on the far turn, was asked for her best in upper stretch and failed to rally. SOUNDS FAMILIAR settled on the outside, waited behind rivals while off the hedge on the far turn, was roused in upper stretch and also failed to rally. NURSE DOLCE was a bit rank while inside

through the first turn, continued along the hedge while under restraint, drafted behind rivals while continuing to save ground on the far turn, checked while blocked in the vicinity of the three-sixteenths pole then dropped out. AUSTRALIS PRINCESS bumped lightly with CAN SHE DANCE at the start, accelerated to the early lead, set the pace through solid fractions, vied inside on the far turn, lost the lead in upper stretch and gave way. IN YOUR DREAMS was rated between rivals, came under urging near the five-sixteenths pole, chased into upper stretch then had nothing left. (Rail at Hedge)
