SHARPS ISLAND was patiently ridden mid-pack, closed fast after last fence to prevail. BAG OF HAMMERS set an easy early pace, then quickened to take a 30 length lead, weakening and caught in stretch. STRAIGHT TO IT raced close throughout, and was one paced final circuit, for an even effort. RED GHOST raced mid-pack, gave a mild rally coming out of final turn to pass tired ones. FOG ISLAND settled in rear of pack, and was never a threat. HOUGHTON REGRETS dropped back and trailed. SUMO POWER tired into the final turn. GRINDING SPEED slipped on landing side of sixth fence and fell.
