WOODFORD PRINCESS was allowed to settle inside, advanced inside on the turn, angled out into the stretch, rallied when clear in the drive and finished with energy to overtake the tiring leader. CINEMA CUTIE sprinted to a long lead early, blew into the stretch far in front but shortened stride in the final furlong. J. C.S JOY was settled to the turn, began a bid but was forced to circle four wide to the stretch, however showed interest late and closed belatedly. AWESOME AUDREY stumbled at the start, recovered then was put in tight quarters and forced to take up after leaving the chute, raced three wide to the stretch and closed some ground late in a better than looked effort. WEXFORD SLEW chased the pace while saving ground to the stretch but had nothing to offer when asked. RHYTHM AND BLOOM was in no hurry early but lacked a response in the drive. RED HOT HONEY chased the pace to the stretch then gave out. BETTIE'S DANCER was not a factor.
