TAYLOR'S PLAN set a contentious pace from the beginning on the inside, continued to battle courageously when challenged by SUMMER LASS and was up by a head bob after a long stretch duel. SUMMER LASS pressed the early pace, came to even terms entering the stretch and fought gamely to the wire to lose by a head bob. TOP CAPPELLETTI tracked the leaders saving ground to the stretch, swung out for the drive and finished willingly. SHE'S ALL FIRED UP chased the leaders from the inside and was unable to mount a rally when asked. TRIBUTETOTHATCHER was hustled up to attend the pace in the turn, loomed boldly at the quarter pole and gave out in the drive. DON'T TELL WENDY was never a factor.
