**Footnotes**

BIG LEAGUE set a pressured pace to the middle of the turn while being well rated, kicked clear at this point, and was all out to hold off GREEN TEAM in the late going. GREEN TEAM raced three wide through the turn, slowly inched up on the winner through the stretch but was held safe. TIME FOR LIBERTY pressed the pace to the middle of the turn on the inside and could not match strides with the leaders in deep stretch but held the show. PRIVATE AVIATOR was off a step slow, swung four wide in the turn for racing room and had little response when asked in the drive. CHUPACABRAS had no impact on the outcome.
