Footnotes

KALOOKAN DANCER emerged from between horses after the break to prompt the early pace three wide, took command once on the turn and drew clear, extended her advantage to the furlong pole then held driving. STEELIN' raced close up early but was blocked in the opening quarter behind the leaders, shifted out to be three wide on the turn and finished steadily in the lane without bothering the winner. LEMON KISS was void of early speed, rallied quickly from the inside into the stretch but lost some of her punch late. VICTORINA broke on the lead but stumbled sharply and fell back steadily to the turn, came four wide to the stretch and finished with some speed. ROYAL KLEVEN was void of any early speed, raced two wide on the turn and finished steadily but never reached serious contention. ORNAMENTAL TORCH settled early, then failed to respond while two wide on the turn. TUCKER'S TUNE broke a bit slow but rushed up to set a pressured pace from the inside to the turn then gave out. HAMMETT STAR stalked two wide and between horses to mid turn and came up empty.
