PHAENNA dueled three wide on the hot pace to the turn, responded to pressure into the stretch, dug in late and held. ONE NUMBER SHORT was allowed to settle, came two wide to the stretch, rallied when set down and closed willingly but too late. BRITE GIRL dueled inside to the stretch, responded gamely to pressure to deep stretch before tiring in the final sixteenth. HARVEST GIRL was outsprinted early, raced three wide to the stretch and lacked a rally. SELECTOR dueled inside to the turn then lacked a closing response. ANNUAL RAINFALL had no speed and was outrun. PEARLESCENT had no speed, came very wide on the turn but had to steady hard to avoid PURGATORY and did not recover. CLASSIC EDGE was outsprinted early, gave out after a half, was eased in the stretch but walked off after crossing the finish line. PURGATORY dueled from between horses to the turn, lugged out to the quarter pole, went wrong into the stretch and pulled up lame.
