Footnotes

SEVENMISS had no speed, advanced four wide to the stretch, rallied when set down, overtook the leaders a sixteenth out and won going away. TEAWAY ROSE stalked the pace to the turn, came three wide to the stretch, rallied steadily but did not switch leads and was overhauled late. CLASSIC ENCORE set a pressured pace from the rail to the stretch, responded to mid stretch but was weakening late. CLASSY LEAH stalked the pace to the turn, tried to rally two wide to the stretch but finished evenly in the drive. KINDON attended the pace from between horses to the stretch but weakened in the final furlong. COURT RECORDER contested the pace outside a three horse spread, took a short advantage at mid stretch but tired late. MORE NO had no speed, saved ground to the stretch but came up empty in the drive. GO FOR LAUNCH was not a factor.
