DROWN THE SORROWS was quickest away, dueled gamely with AFLEET DIABLO to the furlong pole, turned her back and then gamely held off SHINE ALONG while drifting out. SHINE ALONG chased the leaders to the stretch, slowly edged up and closed well but was held off in the final yards. CLASSY BE GONE also chased the leaders, raced four wide through the turn but could not match strides with the first two in the late going. WATER ISSUES lagged to the middle of the of the turn, angled out for the drive and closed with interest while not threatening the top three. TOMBOY MINE tracked the leaders from the inside and had no response when being asked through the turn. AFLEET DIABLO broke alertly to duel with the winner to the eighth pole and gave out quickly in deep stretch. ARTISTIC DREAMER was never a factor. GO FOR LAUNCH raced six wide through the turn and could not rally.
