RICH FACE tracked the leaders to the turn, rallied to take the lead into the stretch and held under steady pressure. SISTER ADIBA was unhurried early, closed some into the stretch then made a good late run in the final furlong. SHEILA chased the leaders to the quarter pole and had a mild late bid. RESTLESS APACHE veered inward at the start, pulled to the lead outside of PRINCESS KOLO, dropped over to the rail at the three eighths pole, came out a bit into the stretch then drifted inward under right handed whipping passing the eighth pole and tired. STEFANDREW had no speed, was caught four wide to the stretch and lacked a response. PRINCESS KOLO had good speed, was passed by RESTLESS APACHE into the turn, angled inside of that one into the stretch, was in tight quarters and took up leaving the furlong marker and gave way. DELMARLADY broke in a tangle and was outrun. A claim of foul by the rider on PRINCESS KOLO against the rider on RESTLESS APACHE for alleged interference in mid stretch was not allowed by the stewards.
