LILIES FOR ROZIE raced as a team with the winner to the second turn, briefly was a bit clear but was re-engaged quickly in upper stretch, dug in gamely under steady urging, looked the winner but lost the nod on the line. MINISTER OF JOY had no speed, saved ground to the stretch then did not threaten the top two while getting CLAIRE SIMOFF for third late. CLAIRE SIMOFF settled inside to the half, came two wide to the stretch then lacked the needed response and missed the show. DIXIE WHISTLE had no speed and settled in the back, tried to respond but drifted four wide on the second turn then came up empty in the lane. DIVINE AFTERNOON chased the top two three wide throughout then gave way. ROCKVILLE TIZZY was fanned four wide to the backstretch, settled to the second turn then had nothing to offer when roused.
