**Footnotes**

EX ANGEL stalked the pace to the turn, was roused three wide, rallied to mid stretch, dueled to deep stretch then inched away under strong pressure. TIP TOE TOPPER also stalked the pace inside of the winner, shifted off the rail into the stretch, rallied and vied for the lead to deep stretch then was bested in the late stages. SURPRISE POWER was crowded by SEA YA WAGER soon after the start, took up and angled to the rail, chased the pace while saving ground to the stretch then finished steadily but was not a threat. ICEE STARS was hustled and dueled from off the rail to the stretch, resisted rivals to mid stretch but tired in the final sixteenth. SEA YA WAGER drifted inward and crowded SURPRISE POWER shortly after the start, tracked the leaders three wide to the stretch but could not muster the needed late response. APRIL'S WAY had no speed, raced widest of all on the backstretch then was three or four wide to the stretch and not a factor. PARADISI showed little.
