SPECIAL HIGH had good speed, dueled outside of EX PARTE three wide on the turn, drifted out to the five path into the stretch but straightened, dug in determinedly and held off JOYFUL CREATOR to the line. JOYFUL CREATOR The latter stalked the leaders to the turn, raced two wide to the stretch then was under vigorous handling in the final furlong, surged late and just missed. EX PARTE attended the pace inside of the winner to the stretch, stayed on with that one to mid stretch but was weakening in the final sixteenth. JANS SIS tracked the leaders early then was outrun on the turn and failed to threaten. MANDAUE CITY had no speed, raced three wide to the stretch and did not reach contention. TOP CROP was outsprinted, chased to the turn then was outrun while four wide and gave out in the drive. OLD WAY was never prominent.
