SLUMBER PARTY raced four wide through the first turn, stalked from the outside down the backstretch, crept up on ANOTHER VARIETY from the beginning of the second turn to the wire and was up in the final stride. ANOTHER VARIETY pulled to the lead from the start, set all the pace but could not hold off the winner in the final stride. ECHOES IN HILCO broke inward, pressed the pace for a half mile, raced four wide through the final turn and could not respond in the drive while drifting in. WON TON TOOSIE tracked the leaders from off the rail and could make no serious inroads on the the leaders. MISS LILY BEE was squeezed back at the start, raced rankly in the first turn, steadied early in the backstretch and was unable to recover.
