NATIVE TRINKET stalked the pace just outside, rallied in the stretch and was along in time. MISS KALENA set the pace on a clear lead but could not hold off the winner. SULTRY SREVA broke inward to bother several foes, raced near the middle of the field and rallied belatedly. POSSULETTA SUE exchanged a bump with DARK RAPIDS at the start, was bothered when SULTRY came over and improved her position in the drive. DARK RAPIDS traded a bump at the break, was bothered shortly after and also improved her position. EMERALD ISLE made a bid in the stretch and faltered. XENAWAR broke slowly and passed tired rivals. CROWNING DIABLO raced close up off the rail and tired. SAINT PRAIRIE was bothered at the start and was always outrun. CALAMITY JANE gave way after a half. MORA DORA was bothered badly at the start and was outrun. AFTER A STEWARDS' INQUIRY THE START, SULTRY SREVA WAS DISQUALIFIED FROM THIRD AND PLACED LAST FOR INTERFERENCE AT THE START.
