GRACILITY saved ground near the middle of the field, angled out in the stretch and gained steadily to be up at the wire. SCARLET O'HARA set a fast pace from the inside and was still clear in the stretch but just failed to hold off the winner. TEJANO HONEY raced just outside near the middle of the field and rallied belatedly for minor awards. TRICKY SURPRISE raced close up inside but lacked a rally. MARGIES CONNECTION stalked the pace just outside and weakened. WESTEND TAPPER never reached a contending position. BE FACTUAL was not a factor. DINNER IN RENO lacked speed and showed little. ROSE OF SAVANNAH was always outrun. MARINE ODYSSEY raced close up off the rail and gave way.
