RURAL QUEEN lacked speed off the rail, came five wide into the stretch, rallied to the front and drew off late. ISBELL AMBIEL lacked speed and rallied for the place while no match for the winner. HEAVENLY BET saved ground near the middle of the field and rallied but lacked a winning late bid. JAKE NOTE stalked the pace and weakened. IN SPYT OF MY EX lacked speed and showed little. SIREN SARAH raced close up and gave way. SPANISH FLASH dropped back steadily. DEVIL'S MILLHOPPER set the pace from the inside and tired. WIDOWS MITE was always outrun and was pulled up in the stretch.
