SWEEPING HOURS came out at the start to bump TESSIES COURAGE, set the pace on a clear lead, was headed by two rivals near the furlong marker then came back gamely in the late going. MALAGRA'S MISTRESS settled in off the inside, angled out four wide for the drive, took a short lead in the stretch then could not hold off the winner. TESSIES COURAGE was bumped at the break, recovered to stalk the pace from off the rail and challenged in the stretch but could not finish with the top two. POPCORN ALLEY raced in good position along the rail but lacked a rally. CHAWNA saved ground while void of speed and showed little. BEYERS FORTUNE raced well away from the inside and was not a factor. DELICATE PLAY raced just outside and was always outrun.
