SHE'S A DRUMMER raced close up off the rail, moved up to challenge on the final turn then drew off through the lane. DURBINETTE set the pace with pressure from the inside then could not handle the bid of the winner while clear for the place. NUTTY RENE' was void of early speed, angled out five wide for the drive and belatedly rallied for a share. QUEENS NOTES was five wide on the first turn, continued outside while lacking speed then improved her position in the run to the wire. HEY HEY pressed the pace from the rail and weakened. MASQUERADE PARTY lacked speed from off the rail and was not a factor. COOL MTN. GIRL settled in early, made a mild bid outside on the second turn but faltered. IRISH TIES settled in along the inside, steadied when she ran up on horses on the backstretch and gave way.
