UNBROKEN CHAIN lacked speed while saving ground, rallied up the fence in the stretch, slipped through inside to get the lead and drew off in the run to the wire. DIXIE BAY settled in near the middle of the field along the rail and rallied in the stretch but was no match for the winner. DUEL TO THE END set a pressured pace from well off the rail but couldn't last. LARK'S SONG raced close up, was fanned six wide into the stretch and improved his position. SCATTER THE CROWD raced near the middle of the field between horses and lacked a rally. SWORD AND STARS lacked speed well away from the inside and passed beaten ones. BRANDONS ROCNROBYN pressed the pace from the outside and tired. OBRIGADA lacked speed, entered the stretch seven deep and was not a factor. GO CAROLINA was through early. MAYBE M. was always outrun. MUIR EIREANN raced close up inside and gave way. SARMARZO PRINCESS trailed throughout.
