Footnotes

BARILOCHE settled mid pack to the half, was roused and rallied three wide on the second turn, pushed to the front in mid stretch then edged away driving. SPEED ROUSER had no speed and saved ground early, shifted out when asked for speed leaving the half, got fanned four wide to the stretch, could not impact the winner but edged away from the rest. TOUCHDOWN CALL dueled from the rail for six furlongs but weakened in the final furlong. MOODY RYTHUM had no speed and settled, offered a bid into the second turn then was eased four wide into the stretch but flattened out in the drive. HESASUPERVALENTINE tracked the leaders to the half, came three wide to the stretch but tired in the lane. DUNGARVAN was allowed to settle to the second turn then came up empty. VOTE dueled for six furlongs then stopped.
