Footnotes

POWERFUL PETE stalked confidently between rivals through the backstretch, responded when clear, slipped through between horses early in the drive and inched to the fore. PRINCELY GIFT raced unhurriedly to the middle of the backstretch, edged up, then rallied strongly through the drive to be up for the place. KENTUCKY SUMMER never far back, loomed nearing the quarter pole and then flattened when more effort was needed. DONE GONE QUACKERS rushed to the front before the first turn, settled and dropped back slightly, took command again before the half mile pole and then faltered in the stretch. U DID IT AGAIN raced in the middle of the pack for a half mile, bid four wide on the second turn and weakened in the stretch. SCOTTISH IDOL showed some speed, dropped back somewhat, then raced evenly to the wire. WIZARD OF DORMELLO broke out at the start, bumped AGITUR and was never a factor. UNUSUAL DOUBLE showed little. AGITUR was bumped hard at the start, clipped heels and was unable to reach contention. IRISH YODELER showed good speed for a half mile and stopped.
